National News

- The **Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana**, which offers loans for micro and small enterprises, completed 10 years. The scheme has four categories: Shishu (up to ₹50,000), Kishore (₹50,000 to ₹5 lakh), Tarun (₹5 lakh to ₹10 lakh), and Tarun Plus (up to ₹20 lakh).
- The Modernization of Command Area Development and Water Management (MCADWM) sub-scheme has been approved under the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana to improve irrigation facilities.
- **Simlipal National Park** in Odisha was officially notified as a national park. It is the only place in the world where melanistic (black) tigers are found.
- The 9th edition of the **Global Technology Summit 2025** took place in New Delhi with the theme "Sabhavana" (Possibilities).
- The **Sagarmala Program**, an initiative by the Ministry of Ports, Shipping, and Waterways, completed 10 years.
- An Inter-AIMS Referral Portal was announced by the Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare, J.P. Nadda, to facilitate referrals between AIIMS hospitals.

- The **Baisabi Festival** is a New Year celebration observed by the Chakma, Marma, and Tripura communities in Bangladesh.
- Mauritius has become the first African country and the fourth globally to sign the Country Partnership Framework (CPF) with the International Solar Alliance (ISA).
- A commemorative stamp was released during President Droupadi Murmu's visit to Portugal to mark 50 years of diplomatic relations between India and Portugal.
- The Huangmaozhou Bridge in China, part of the Shantou-Kanyun Expressway, was inaugurated.
