# Monthly Compilation: Key Current Affairs – February 2024

# Major Appointments, Awards, and Honors

### **State and National Leadership**

- State Fruit Declaration: Assam officially declared 'Kaji Nemu' (Kaji Lemon) as its state fruit.
- Chief Minister of Jharkhand: Champai Soren from JMM became the new Chief Minister after Hemant Soren's resignation and arrest.
- Vice Chief of Indian Army: Lt. General Upendra Dwivedi was appointed to this post.
- First Woman Chief Minister in a Province of Pakistan: Maryam Nawaz became the CM of Punjab province.

#### **National and International Honors**

- Bharat Ratna 2024: Five individuals were awarded India's highest civilian honor, Bharat Ratna:
  - Chaudhary Charan Singh (Posthumous; former Prime Minister)
  - **P.V. Narasimha Rao** (Posthumous; former Prime Minister)
  - o M.S. Swaminathan (Posthumous; agricultural scientist, "Father of Green Revolution in India")
  - L.K. Advani (living; former Deputy Prime Minister)
  - **Karpoori Thakur** (Posthumous; former Chief Minister of Bihar)
- Honorary Knighthood: Sunil Bharti Mittal became the first Indian citizen to receive an honorary knighthood from King Charles III of the UK.

### **Judicial and Administrative Appointments**

- Chief Justices: New Chief Justices were appointed to several High Courts:
  - o Karnataka: Justice N.V. Anjaria
  - Uttarakhand: Justice Ritu Bahri (first woman Chief Justice for the state)
  - **Meghalaya**: Justice S. Vadynathan
  - o Gauhati: Justice Vijay Bishnoi
- Lokpal (Ombudsman) of India: Justice A.M. Khanwilkar was appointed as the new Lokpal Chairperson.
- CMD of IRCTC: Sanjay Kumar Jain was appointed to this role.

# Notable Dates and Observances

- Indian Coast Guard Day: 1 February (48th edition in 2024).
- World Wetlands Day: 2 February (Theme: "Wetlands and Human Well-being").
- World Unani Day: 11 February (marking the birth anniversary of Hakim Ajmal Khan).
- National Productivity Day: 12 February.
- National Women's Day (India): 13 February.
- Central Excise Day (India): 24 February.
- National Protein Day: 27 February.
- National Science Day: 28 February (commemorating the discovery of the Raman Effect by CV Raman).

# **Example 1** Key Legislation and Government Initiatives

#### **State Initiatives**

- Uniform Civil Code (UCC): Uttarakhand became the first state in independent India to pass a UCC bill. It aims to create a common set of laws for all citizens on matters like marriage, divorce, and inheritance, exempting Scheduled Tribes.
- Jal Jeevan Mission: Arunachal Pradesh became the first northeastern state to achieve 100% household tap water connection.

- Odisha Swatantra Scheme: Odisha launched this scheme to provide interest-free loans up to ₹1 lakh to youth (aged 18-35) for business ventures.
- Haryana's 'Van Mitra' Scheme: This initiative aims to promote afforestation by incentivizing locals to plant trees.

#### **National Initiatives**

- PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana: This scheme provides up to 300 units of free electricity per month to households that install rooftop solar panels, with a goal of covering one crore households.
- Indo-Myanmar Border Fencing: India plans to fence the entire 1,643 km border to end the free movement regime and enhance security.
- Shahpur Kandi Barrage: Completed on the Ravi river in Pathankot, Punjab, it now allows India to prevent the river's water from flowing into Pakistan as per the Indus Water Treaty.



## **Science, Education, and Environment**

## Museums and Heritage

- First National Epigraphy Museum: The foundation was laid in Hyderabad at the Salar Jung Museum, to be developed by the Archaeological Survey of India.
- First Vedic Clock: Installed at Ujjain's Jantar Mantar, Madhya Pradesh, it displays time according to the Indian Panchang.
- First BAPS Hindu Temple in Middle East: Inaugurated in Abu Dhabi, UAE.
- First Regional Centre of Sangeet Natak Akademi: To be established in Hyderabad.

## **Conservation and Biodiversity**

- Biodiversity Heritage Site: Odisha declared the Gupteswar Forest in Koraput as its fourth Biodiversity Heritage Site.
- Ramsar Sites in India: India now has 80 Ramsar sites after adding five new sites (three in Karnataka, two in Tamil Nadu).

• Thay Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary: Tamil Nadu announced the establishment of this new wildlife sanctuary.

### **Space and Technology**

- New ISRO Spaceport: Foundation stone was laid for India's second spaceport at Kulasekarapattinam, Tamil Nadu, which will be used for launching small satellites.
- Gaganyaan Mission Astronauts: Four Indian Air Force pilots were designated as astronaut candidates for India's first crewed space mission: Group Captains Prashanth Balakrishnan Nair, Ajit Krishna, Angad Pratap, and Wing Commander Shubhangshu Shukla
- World's First Wooden Satellite: Named "LignoSat", this satellite is scheduled for launch in 2024.
- India's First Indigenous Smart Ammunition: A 155mm smart ammunition was developed through a collaboration between IIT Madras and Munitions India Limited.

# Major Indian and International Events

#### **Sports**

- Badminton Asia Team Championships 2024: The Indian women's team won their first-ever gold medal.
- Khelo India University Games 2023: Chandigarh University was declared the overall champion.
- **Khelo India Winter Games**: The mascot was **'Sheen-e She'** (Snow Leopard); the event was hosted in Ladakh and Gulmarg.
- Under-19 Men's Cricket World Cup: Australia defeated India in the final to clinch the trophy.
- FIFA World Cup 2026: To be co-hosted by the USA, Canada, and Mexico.
- 45th Chess Olympiad: Will be hosted by Hungary.

#### **International Relations and Diplomacy**

- MILAN Naval Exercise (12th Edition): Conducted in Visakhapatnam with over 50 participating countries.
- **Dosti Tri-lateral Exercise (16th Edition)**: Held in Malé, Maldives, with India and Sri Lanka as participants and Bangladesh as an observer.
- Indian Ocean Conference (7th Edition): Held in Perth, Australia; theme: "Towards a Stable and Sustainable Indian Ocean".
- International Court of Justice (ICJ): Nawaf Salam of Lebanon was elected as its
  President.
- World Trade Organization's 13th Ministerial Conference: Held in Abu Dhabi, UAE;
   Comoros and Timor-Leste joined as new members.
- Financial Action Task Force (FATF) Grey List: Namibia and Kenya were added, while UAE, Barbados, Gibraltar, and Uganda were removed.

## **Economic Updates**

- India's Projected GDP Growth for 2024-25: The Reserve Bank of India projected a GDP growth of 7%.
- Corruption Perception Index 2023: India was ranked 93rd out of 180 countries.
