1. Technology and Security 💻 🔒

 Juice Jacking Warning: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) warned against using public charging ports due to the risk of juice jacking. This cyberattack can steal data from mobile devices connected to tampered public charging stations.

2. India – National Updates 🌊

- **Operation Indravati:** India launched this evacuation operation to rescue its nationals from Haiti amid severe civil unrest, moving them to the Dominican Republic.
- Battery Gigafactory: India's first battery energy storage gigafactory, with a 12 GWh capacity by 2026, will be established in Jammu & Kashmir by Good Enough Energy.
- Jharkhand's Widow Remarriage Scheme: The state of Jharkhand introduced a scheme offering ₹2 lakhs as an incentive for widows who remarry. The application must be filed within a year of remarriage, and it has specific conditions regarding age and employment.
- International Women's Day 2024: Celebrated on March 8th, its theme was "Invest in Women: Accelerate Progress," aligning with Sustainable Development Goal #5 on gender equality.

4. National and International Awards 🏆



- Bhutan's Highest Civilian Award: Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi was awarded the Order of the Druk Gyalpo, Bhutan's highest civilian honor.
- Abel Prize 2024: Awarded to Michel Talagrand for his significant work in probability theory.
- Pritzker Architecture Prize 2024: Japan's Riken Yamamoto was the recipient of this prestigious architectural award.
- Sahitya Akademi Awards 2023: Neelam Saran Gour (English) and Sanjeev (Hindi) received this literary award, which recognizes works in 24 Indian languages.
- Oscars 2024: The film "Oppenheimer" swept many major categories, winning Best Picture, Best Director (Christopher Nolan), Best Actor (Cillian Murphy), and Best Supporting Actor (Robert Downey Jr.). **Emma Stone** won Best Actress for "Poor Things."
- Ramon Magsaysay Award 2024: This award was given to Amitav Ghosh for his work on climate change.

5. Sports Highlights 🏏 🚷

- Ranji Trophy 2024: Mumbai won the title, defeating Vidarbha in the final.
- Pro Kabaddi League Season 10: Puneri Paltan secured their first title by beating the Haryana Steelers. Aslam Inamdar was named the Most Valuable Player.
- WPL 2024: The Royal Challengers Bangalore won the Women's Premier League by defeating the Delhi Capitals.
- Miss World 2024: The 71st Miss World title, held in Mumbai, was won by Krystyna Pyszková of the Czech Republic. The original data provided an incorrect name and country for the winner.
- Paralympic Committee of India President: Indian para-athlete and two-time gold medalist **Devendra Jhajharia** was elected as the new president.

6. Science, Infrastructure, and Innovation 🚀 🟦



- World's First Under-River Metro Tunnel: Inaugurated in Kolkata, this metro tunnel runs under the Hooghly River, connecting Howrah Maidan and Esplanade.
- Ganga Dolphin Research Center: Established at Patna University, Bihar.
- First Indigenous Prototype Fast Breeder Nuclear Reactor: Located in Kalpakkam,

Tamil Nadu.

- SELA Tunnel Project: The Border Roads Organisation (BRO) constructed this world-class two-lane tunnel at 13,000 feet, connecting Assam and Arunachal Pradesh.
- Al Robot Teacher 'Iris': Deployed in Kerala, Iris is India's first generative Al educator in a school.
- Agni-V Missile Test: India successfully tested the Agni-V missile with MIRV (Multiple Independently Targetable Reentry Vehicle) technology, which allows a single missile to deliver multiple warheads to different targets.

7. Social Programs and International Affairs 🌍 🤝



- Indiraamma Housing Scheme: A social program in Telangana that provides financial assistance and a house plot to the poor and homeless.
- Sweden Joins NATO: Sweden became the 32nd member of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO).
- Francis Scott Key Bridge Collapse: In Baltimore, Maryland, USA, the Francis Scott Key Bridge collapsed after a cargo ship struck one of its support pillars.
- Joint Military Exercises: Samudra Lakshmana: A naval exercise between India and Malaysia.
 - Laamitye 2024: A joint military exercise between India and Seychelles.
 - Sea Defenders 2024: A maritime exercise involving the Indian and US Coast Guards.
- Chhapchar Kut Festival: This is a major spring festival celebrated in Mizoram, marking the end of the Jhum (slash-and-burn) agricultural clearing.

8. Economy and Rankings III



- UNDP Human Development Index 2022: India was ranked 134th out of 193 countries.
- World Happiness Report: India ranked 126th out of 143 nations. Finland was named the happiest country for the seventh consecutive year.
- World Air Quality Report 2023 (IQAir): Bangladesh had the worst air quality, followed by Pakistan, with India ranking third.
- Geographical Indication (GI) Tags: Several products received GI tags, including Bangla Muslin from West Bengal, Majuli Mask from Assam, and Narsapur Lace Crochet from Andhra Pradesh.
